GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus seeking release of Jai Bahadur stated to be illegally detained by respondent No.3.
2. Pursuant to interim directions issued by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 14.5.2019 a Warrant Officer went to the Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar where Jai Bahadur (alleged detainee) was found to be sitting on a chair “freely” in the reporting room. Upon queries made by the Warrant Officer, it was disclosed that he was not wanted or arrested in any case and had come to the Police Station on his own. Learned counsel for the petitioner has today

informed that one FIR was lodged against Sunish Kumar son of the detenue and that the detenue was unnecessarily being called to the Police Station in connection with the aforesaid FIR lodged on 10.05.2019.

3. In view of the aforestated position, wherein the alleged detenue who was found in the Police Station although not specifically found to be forcibly detained there and has been released, no further direction is required to be issued in this case.
4. The petition, as such is disposed off. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to have recourse to any other remedy as available to him under the law.
