None for the petitioner. Even on the last date there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

The prayer in this petition is to issue a directions to the respondent to hold an inquiry on the representation dated 13.10.2017 filed by the petitioner.

Reply by way of short affidavit of Davinder Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle, Patran, District Patiala on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has been filed by learned State counsel today in Court and is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

As per the reply, the petitioner is a habitual offender and is involved in as many as five FIRs. It is further stated that the petitioner has given many applications to different public persons for the same grievance and 20 of such applications have already been disposed of or decided as the petitioner in some cases has effected a compromise. It is further submitted in the complaint dated 30.10.2017, it is stated he was picked up by the police

and kept in illegal detention by DSP Patran.

The inquiry was marked to Superintendent of Police, Head Quarter, Patiala. Thereafter, on a request made by the petitioner, the inquiry was got conducted by the Superintendent of Police, Head Quarter, Patiala and after joining both the parties it was concluded that the application is filed with an intention to put pressure on the local police regarding registration of FIR No.233 dated 07.10.2017 at Police Station, Patran, in which, the petitioner is one of the accused. Accordingly, the allegations made in the representation was found to be false.

In view of the above, no further action is called for. This petition is rendered infructuous.
