Petitioners have filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of impugned order dated 21.12.2012 (Annexure P-10) whereby petitioner along with other co-accused have been charged under Sections 406, 467, 468, 201 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code by Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Moonak and order dated 18.11.2013 (Annexure P-12) vide which revision petition filed by the petitioners has been dismissed.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sat Parkash has apprised the Court that prosecution has already examined 18 witnesses and the trial is at the fag end. This fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioners.

Considering the nature and the stage of the trial and the fact that
