This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of the FIR No. 14 dated 02.02.2014, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) (Anneuxre P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise.

Heard.

Vide order dated 01.11.2018, both the parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the trial Court and learned Magistrate was directed to submit its report.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dera Bassi, vide its letter dated 13.12.2018 has reported that parties have compromise the matter and she is satisfied that the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion and undue influence.

Since the matter has been compromised and the trial of the case will be useless exercise, FIR No. 14 dated 02.02.2014, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) (Annexure P-1) along with consequential proceedings stand quashed qua petitioners.
