1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and of other members of his family including his minor daughter Rinaaz Arora as he apprehends threat to the same at the hands of his wife i.e. respondent No.4-Sahiba Arora.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that his wife is mentally disturbed and although she is presently residing in her parental home but the minor daughter of the petitioner namely Rinaaz Arora is also residing with her and that respondent No.4 had earlier attempted to administer poison to the minor child and thus the petitioner apprehends threat to the life of his minor child at the hands of respondent No.4 on account of the disturbed mental condition of his wife Sahiba Arora (respondent No.4).

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on merits of the case or on the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of representation dated 9.5.2019 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law.
4. A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-3 be sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
