The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.99 dated 17.04.2019, under Sections 149, 323, 324, 427, 452 and 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added later on) registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners are that they along with several others had forcibly entered the house of the complainant and inflicted injuries on the complainant. He further contends that there is only one injury which is a fracture of the middle finger of his left hand. The petitioner No.1 is 18 years old and petitioner No.2 is 19 years of age and they are in custody for over a month. They are not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel states that the challan has not been presented before the Court.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners, especially when the petitioner No.1 is 18 years old and petitioner No.2 is 19 years of age, they are not involved in any other case and are in custody for over 1 month, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
