The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to transfer the investigation pertaining to FIR No.006 dated 6.1.2019 registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar under Sections 21 and 61 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 to some independent agency or to Crime Branch, Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR No.006 dated 6.1.2019 has been lodged against the petitioner solely on account of the fact that she has been pursuing the matter pertaining to lodging of a false FIR against her son and had also made several complaints against police officers i.e. against respondents No.4 to 7 and that now in order to pressurize her and to harass her, she has herself been falsely implicated in the present case.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Police Head Quarters, Punjab, Sector-9, Chandigarh to look into the matter and to dispose off the representation dated 15.3.2019 (Annexure P-6), moved by petitioner, in accordance with law, at the earliest and also to ensure that the matter is fairly and expeditiously investigated.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 15.3.2019 (Annexure P-6) be sent to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Police Head Quarters, Punjab, Sector-9, Chandigarh, so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.
