Prayer in both these petitions is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No.47 dated 01.05.2019 under Sections 61/78 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914,
registered at Police Station Chajjli, District Sangrur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 17.05.2019: -

“.... Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, which was registered on the basis of some secret information that the petitioners are involved in bringing the liquor in the State of Punjab which was meant for sale in the State of Haryana and they are coming on a motorcycle and a car. The police stopped the motorcycle and the car and as per the further allegations, the person driving the motorcycle as well as 02 occupants of the car ran away from the spot and a recovery of 204 bottles of country-made liquor was effected. It is further submitted that the recovery has already been effected and the petitioners- Gursewak Singh @ Sewak and Amandeep Singh @ Tattu, are ready to join the investigation....”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Malkiat Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 17.05.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
