During the pendency of this petition claiming parole, the petitioner was granted furlough by the Jail Authorities for three weeks to meet his family with direction to surrender himself at Jail on 30.08.2019, effectively rendering the petition infructuous.

In these circumstances, the petitioner would have to start afresh with an application for parole, which can be processed and decided in accordance with law.

Consequently, the instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for parole on any of the justified ground/s and in case such an application is filed, it would be decided by the authorities within the timeline laid down by the instructions issued by the State Government from time to time.
