Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.1 to conduct a fair, independent and impartial investigation in FIR No.188 dated 25.12.2017 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149 and Section 307 (added later on) of IPC, at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, (Rural), Ferozepur is on record and as per the reply, it is stated that the police has tried to arrest the accused person as some of them have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, has stated on completion of investigation challan stand presented on 23.10.2019 Mohinder Singh, Surinder Singh, Nirmal Singh and Gurpreet Singh and one person Baggi, S/o Hari Singh is yet to be arrested and as and when he is arrested the challan shall

be presented against him.

Learned State counsel further submits that in the investigation four other co-accused were declared innocent.

In view of the same, counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to move an appropriate application before the trial Court for seeking the report on the basis of which the aforesaid four persons were declared innocent and also to move an appropriate application at appropriate stage regarding his right to summon these persons/or for further investigation in terms of his right under Section 173 (8) Cr.P.C.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
