Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.56 dated 11.04.2019 under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Urban Estate, District Patiala.

On 17.05.2019 the following order was passed by this Court:

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Mr. Vishal Goel, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant.

Adjourned to 22.07.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do

so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-21838 and 21584 of 2019.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Iqbal Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 17.05.2019 is made absolute.
