Petitioner prays for quashing of FIR No. 123 and 5.7.2017 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Sh.Randeep Singh, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and submits that the dispute between the parties has been resolved and therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned State counsel also on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh submits that the entire payment has already been made to the Bank-respondent No.2. Offences are compoundable with the permission of the Court. Once the entire payment has been made, nothing further survives in the present dispute. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 and 2 also do not have any objection.

In view thereof, FIR No.123 and 5.7.2017 registered under

Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
