Pursuant to the order of this Court (coordinate Bench) dated 20.05.2019, admitting the petitioner to interim bail, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjit Kanwal, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation.

That being so and the fact that in the only other criminal case registered against the petitioner, he is stated to have been acquitted, even as per the learned State counsel, and the allegation in the present FIR being that he ran away from the spot when intoxicant powder was alleged to have been recovered from one Kulwant Kaur, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, the order dated 20.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
