This petition was filed seeking appropriate directions to respondents No.2 to 4 not to summon the petitioner in criminal cases. The grievance of the petitioner is that his Aadhar Card has been morphed/forged and used to give bail bonds/sureties in various bail applications on behalf of the petitioner. One such case came to the notice of the trial Court wherein it was recorded that the petitioner is not involved in this racket, however, still the police was not taking any action.

On 24.05.2019, the following order was passed:-

*“Even after, it has come to the notice of the Haryana Police that for the purposes of giving sureties/bail bonds in the Court, Aadhar Card of the petitioner is being misused, the police refused to take any action. One of the Court after examining documents brought before it, has already found that the petitioner is not involved in this racket. Still the police has not taken any action to prevent such frauds.*

*Commissioner of Police, Gurugram, is directed to file his*

*affidavit as to what action he proposes to take against the guilty and prevent such frauds.*

*Let the affidavit be filed before the date fixed. If, no affidavit is filed, the Commissioner of Police shall remain present in Court on the next date of hearing.*

*Adjourned to 03.07.2019.”*

Today, a status report has been filed by way of affidavit of Mohd. Akil, Commissioner of Police, Gurugram wherein it has been pointed out that Special Investigation Team (SIT) under Assistant Commissioner of Police, Pataudi has been constituted which is thoroughly investigating the matter. Copy of the affidavit is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has assured the Court that Special Investigation Team would go to the root of the matter and take suitable action required under law. However, learned counsel for the petitioner apprehend that the moment the petition is disposed of, the Special Investigation Team would not take any action.

Keeping in view the contents of the aforesaid affidavit, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition, if in future any cause arises.
