The petitioners have prayed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 04.10.2017 passed by the Collector dismissing their petition filed under Section 11 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 for seeking declaration of their title over the land in dispute and order dated 01.02.2019 vide which their appeal has also been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has though argued vehemently but he could not prove their possession, firstly continuously from 26.01.1950 and secondly that they have the title also because they are recorded in the *jamabandi* as "*gair marusi* paying rent". No other point has been raised.

In view thereof, we do not find any reason to interfere in the well reasoned order passed by the Courts below.

Dismissed.
