AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The writ petition filed by the petitioner challenging deduction of ₹2,500/- per month from his pension was allowed on 03.12.2018. The recovery amount of ₹51,863/- as calculated by the respondent was set aside and it was directed that amount already recovered shall be refunded with 6% interest per annum. The present contempt petition has been filed as needful has not been done.

Reply by way of affidavit on behalf of respondents filed today in the Court, is taken on record. Copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per pleadings in paragraph No.4 of the reply, principal amount of ₹42,500 has been refunded alongwith interest amounting to ₹4,892/-. The amount has been deposited in account No.00259000300587229 (IFSC Code PUNB0025900) in Punjab National Bank, in the name of the petitioner.

In view of reply filed, no further interference is called for in the contempt proceedings.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

However, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law, if grievance still survives.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
