The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.646 dated 11.12.2018 at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, wherein the allegations broadly are to the effect that the accused had cheated the complainant of an amount of ₹6.02 lacs on the pretext of getting employment in Northern Railways.

Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the parties are closely related inter se and the differences between the parties have been resolved and a compromise has been effected between them. The learned counsel, in this context, has referred to the

affidavit (Annexure P-2) executed by the Gurvinder Singh regarding the parties having compromised the matter.

The aforesaid position is not disputed by the learned State counsel, who has verified the aforesaid fact from the Investigating Officer namely ASI Ranjot Singh, who is present in Court.

In view of the aforesaid position when the parties are stated to be closely related and the matter is stated to have been compromised, the petition is accepted and it is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
