Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners as also to issue direction to respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

In the reply filed by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Dasuay, District Hoshiarpur, it is stated that from the inquiry and medico-legal report of Amit Kumar-petitioner No.1, offence under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC were made out and since the same are non-cognizable, an FIR was not registered and DDR No.46 dated 21.05.2018 was recorded. It is further stated that later on petitioner No.3 and petitioner No.4 namely Vijay Kumar and Sanjeev Kumar handed over a copy of compromise dated 22.5.2018 to the police and thereafter again an application was given by respondent No.4-Sanjeev Rana dated 18.6.2016 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur and DSP (H), Hoshiarpur recommended to take preventive action under Section 151, 107 Cr.P.C against the petitioners and private respondents.

In view of the above, no further action is called for.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
