In terms of order dated 03.12.2019, the applicant/petitioner approached to the office of respondent-Commission on 11.12.2019 and with regard to Question No.57, it was found that against this question, the applicant-petitioner has given answer by putting mark on two options and that is why the answer has been deleted. As per result, the petitioner has secured 136 marks in the written examination.

Learned State counsel stated that the petitioner has secured 136 marks in written examination as per HSSC result, but as per HSSC first answer key, the petitioner has to be given 140 marks. However, as per revised answer key, the petitioner get 138 marks. The petitioner belongs to SC category and last selected candidate in this category has secured 152 marks and candidates securing 151 marks were put in the waiting list.

Since the applicant-petitioner has secured less than the marks of the last candidate of the waiting list, no ground is made out for review of the order in question.

In view of the above, the review application is dismissed.
