This a contempt petition pleading willful disobedience of the order dated 14.11.2018 passed in CWP-28728-2018. The relevant portion of the said order is reproduced below:-

“In view of above, present writ petition stands disposed of with the directions to the respondents to look into legal notice dated 02.09.2018 (Annexure P25) and take the required decision thereon, expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Ms. Nirvikar Grewal, Assistant Law Officer is present in Court on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2. She has produced the order dated 01.08.2019 whereby the legal notice dated 02.09.2018 given by the petitioner has been decided. She further submits that copy of the order has

been sent to the petitioner.

In view of the order produced, no cause of action survives to the petitioner for pursuing the present contempt petition. The contempt petition is disposed of.

If still aggrieved, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

However, in case, if there is any disobedience in the statement made today, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.

Rule issued against respondents is hereby discharged.
