AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 06.09.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No.18479 of 2016.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“4. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, perusing the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by directing respondent No.3 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 28.3.2016 (Annexure P-5), in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified

copy of the order.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Ms. Sonal Goel, Administrator, HSVP, Faridabad has been filed today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. Alongwith the reply, orders dated 24.05.2019 and 28.05.2019 have been annexed wherein claim of the petitioner for allotment of alternative plot has been accepted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law if grievance still survives.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous, with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
