The petitioners, who are mother-in-law and father-in-law of respondent No.2-complainant Sukhvinder Kaur have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest in FIR No.241 dated 03.09.2018 under Sections 324, 323, 34, 120-B IPC

(Sections 406, 498-A and 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Talwandi Saboo, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that during pendency of the present petition, the matter has been compromised between the parties and accordingly, a petition i.e. *CRM-M-44526 of 2019* titled as *Jaswinder Kaur and others Versus State of Punjab and another* has been filed by the petitioners along with other co-accused for quashing of the aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise.

He further states that the petitioners were granted interim bail by this Court vide order dated November 02, 2018 in terms of order dated November 01, 2018 passed in *CRM-M-48629 of 2018* titled as *Gurvinder Kaur and another Versus State of Punjab* and in compliance of the subsequent order dated February 06, 2019 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Gurpreet Singh, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 02.11.2018, whereby the petitioners were granted interim bail by this Court in terms of order dated November 01, 2018 passed in *CRM-M-48629 of 2018* titled as *Gurvinder Kaur and another Versus State of Punjab* is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
