Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.83 dated 20.04.2019, registered at Police Station Khanna City-2, Ludhiana, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, Suraj has committed suicide. As per the FIR, he was harassed by the persons, who had to take money from him. Neither in the suicide note nor in the FIR, any detail regarding abetment has been mentioned. As per the FIR, the deceased has named seven-eight persons, who are responsible for his death.

The petitioner is in custody since 20.04.2019. She is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as she is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
