The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation and for registration of a criminal case on the basis of complaints dated 19.1.2019 and 23.1.2019 (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that an attempt was made to take forcible possession of land of the petitioner and that infact on 19.1.2019 Kulwant Singh and Mangal Singh alongwith other accused, who were armed with weapons, forcibly plowed the mustard crops sown in the fields by the petitioner. The learned counsel, in this context, has referred to the photographs annexed with the petition as Annexure P-1.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa

to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 23.1.2019 (Annexure P-3), moved by petitioner, in accordance with law, at the earliest.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 23.1.2019 (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.
