Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.3 to 8. Prayer has also been made to issue direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to properly investigate the FIR No.34 dated 07.02.2016 under Sections 354, 341, 451, 506, 34 IPC, Police Station Tripri Town, District Patiala and to take appropriate action against respondents No.7 and 8 in accordance with law.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioners.

Supplementary status report has already been filed by way of affidavit of Sukhamrit Singh Randhawa, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police City-II, Patiala in compliance of orders dated 18.11.2016 and 14.03.2017 passed by this Court.

ASI Amar Singh, who is present in the Court, states that

cancellation report in the case has been prepared, which fact is also evident

from the status report filed by way of affidavit dated 05.06.2017 by Sukhamrit Singh Randhawa, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police City-II, Patiala, wherein it has been stated that cancellation report in the case has been forwarded to the learned Illaqa Magistrate, Patiala through Senior Police Officers by the SHO, Police Station Tripuri, Patiala, vide No.3198/5A dated 02.08.2016.

Considering the fact that the police has already prepared cancellation report, the prayer of the petitioner for proper investigation of FIR no more survives and the present petition is accordingly, dismissed.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to avail the remedy(s) as available under law.
