This order shall dispose off pre-arrest bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. moved in FIR No. 229 dated 15.04.2016 under Sections 354-D and 201 IPC, Police Station Sector 10-A, Gurugram.

Learned State counsel Mr. Baljinder Virk, DAG, Haryana assisted by ASI Lakhwinder Singh, Police Station Sector 10-A, Gurugram submits that petitioner Ajit was arrested on 08.05.2016 and was released on regular bail by the Court below and subsequent thereto during the course of proceedings before the concerned Court, he absented himself on 06.11.2017 in putting appearance.

To the very specific query of the Court to the counsel for the petitioner as to what are substantial reasons for the petitioner to remain absent from the Court for such a long period of time, counsel

was at loss of words and fairly concedes that there is no substantial reasons except the fact that the father of the petitioner had expired on 06.08.2017. However, subsequent thereto the conduct of the petitioner rather abundantly reflects his insolence towards the law and since he has not put in appearance before the trial Court without any substantial reasons, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out and the same stands dismissed.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days.
