The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.71 dated 06.05.2019, under Section 379 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners in the FIR are that attempt was made to steal the transformer and some parts have allegedly been stolen. He further contends that the FIR was registered after a delay of two days. He also contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the case and are not involved in any other case.

This Court, by order dated 17.05.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 17.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
