Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.02 dated 02.01.2019 under Sections 307, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Civil Lines, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has not caused any injury to the brother of the complainant (injured) and only allegation against the petitioner is that he caught hold of the injured. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 02.01.2019.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the investigation is complete and the challan has been presented.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial

Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
