ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 143, dated 03.11.2017, under Sections 307, 326, 325, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury which is attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature and injury which attracted Section 307 IPC has been attributed to co-accused. The petitioner is in custody for over a year since his arrest on 04.04.2018. He further contends that the injured have fully recovered from the injuries.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Surinder Singh states that 03 out of 23 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over a year and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
