Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.147 dated 11.07.2018 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sector 3 (North), Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 14.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-44987-2018. He submits that from the reading of the FIR, main allegations are against Jasmer Singh who has been released on bail.

Learned counsel for the Union Territory, Chandigarh disputes this position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and for the reasons recorded in order dated 14.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-44987-2018, petitioner is also directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
