The petitioner has approached this Court seeking registration of First Information Report for the offences under Sections 427/380/506/120-B IPC against the private respondents/culprits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was running his business on a part of the property owned by Mohan Lal and that on 23.06.2017, respondents No. 5 to 14, the private respondents namely Mohit Sharma, Rajnish Shanti, Anil Rana, Pankaj Pappu, Gurbakhshish Singh Bhatti, Teja Singh, Jatinder Singh, Baljinder Singh Bittu, Kamal Kapoor and Surinder Singh Shindi who are counsellors and officials of Municipal Council, Nabha entered into his premises with JCB Machine and demolished the boundary, walls and sheds and also stole and carried away some valuable parts.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

While this Court is unable to comment on the action taken by the Municipal Council in demolishing the premises which perhaps has been done in accordance with provisions of law but the allegations of theft need to be looked into.

The petition, as such, is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3 to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-2).

A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-2) be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (respondent No.3) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
