TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Petitioners raise a grievance that they are being prevented from running their lottery business from their respective shops/stalls within the municipal limits of Sangrur inspite of having necessary permission/authority/license under the provisions of the Lotteries (Regulation) Act, 1998, Lotteries (Regulations) Rules, 2010 and Punjab State Lotteries Rules, 2015.

Having heard counsel for the petitioners at length, instant petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to agitate their grievance before respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur along with all supporting/relevant documents in support of their stand that they are duly authorized and are license holders from the competent authority to run their lottery business.

In the eventuality of any such application/representation being preferred before respondent No.3 along with the requisite supporting

documents, respondent No.3 would be obligated to examine the same and to thereafter take necessary steps as he may deem fit in accordance with law.
