The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 10.12.2018, vide which, the writ petition was dismissed as withdrawn with the following observations:-

“Dismissed as Withdrawn”.

The ancillary prayer for the non-supply of the required record, the petitioner would have full opportunity during the enquiry to summon the relevant record in accordance with law.”

It is contended that the petitioner had asked for summoning the witness and record from the enquiry officer. His both the applications have been rejected by the Department and the enquiry officer accepted the rejection of the Department.

The petitioner is at liberty to challenge the order rejecting his application seeking summoning of the records and the witness as the case may be in accordance with law but no contempt is made out.

The contempt petition is dismissed.
