Report dated 21.09.2018 of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jaitu has been received whereby after recording statements of respondent/complainant-Baljeet Kaur and accused/petitioners, namely, Hardeep Singh @ Deepa, Satnam Kaur, Baljeet Kaur, Baljinder Kaur, Balwinder Kaur @ Bholi, Pardeep Singh, Partap Singh, Ninder Kaur, Sohan Singh @ Sonu and Jasmeet Kaur, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the

fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 81 dated 30.07.2016 under Sections 498-A, 406, 494, 420, 323, 506, 120-B and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
