Ms. Nidhi Garg, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent State.

In the circumstances, interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join the investigation within seven days and disclose all the facts to the police and cooperate in investigation. In the event of his arrest, he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. To be heard along with CRM-M No.49099 of 2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Balwinder Singh does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh further states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 05.11.2018 is made absolute.
