FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

At the very onset, learned State counsel submits that petitioner No.1-Rohtash Singh son of Harnarain has since died on 20.05.2019 and placed on record his death certificate duly attested by the the police official assisting him ASI Kavita.

In view of statement made by the learned State counsel, counsel for the petitioner has made statement withdrawing the present petition qua petitioner No.1-Rohtash Singh.

Petition qua petitioner No. 1 stands dismissed as withdrawn.

Registry to give a note on the head note of the petition to this effect.

Report dated 07.08.2019 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class has been received whereby after recording statements of petitioners Rohtash Singh (since died), Nargish, Rekha, Krishana and Rekha and complainant Nirmala, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and considering the fact that the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 100 dated 21.09.2018 registered at Police Station Rewari, District Rewari under Sections 323, 354-B, 341, 355, 506 and 34 IPC and all

consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners No. 2 to 5 are quashed and petition qua petitioner No. 1 is dismissed as withdrawn.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
