GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.15, dated 14.11.2018, registered at Police Station Aur, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 363, 366 IPC, and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 20.5.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the Trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.
3. Report of learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of complainant Manjit Kaur and victim Parveen Kaur as well as of petitioner/accused Ravi Kumar @ Naresh Kumar, have

been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant as well as victim have specifically stated that the matter has been compromised with the petitioner and they do not want to pursue with the matter. Learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, opined that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily and without any pressure or coercion.

4. In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.15, dated 14.11.2018, registered at Police Station Aur, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 363, 366 IPC, and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
