Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to save the petitioner from harassment and mental torture at the hands of respondent no.7 and to register an FIR regarding the embezzlement of Employees Provident Funds.

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, an affidavit of Sandeep Kumar Garg, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur has been filed by learned State counsel. Perusal of paragraph 4 of the affidavit reveals that on the basis of the complaint made by the present petitioner against M/s G & S Services Mantra, Rama Mandi, District Bathinda – respondent no.7, the matter was enquired into and consequently FIR no.18 dated 23.01.2019 under Sections 14 and 14(A) of the Employees Provident Funds and Misc. Provisions Act, 1952 at Police Station City Sangrur has been registered and the investigation is going on.
