Reply dated 14.1.2019 by way of affidavit of Susheela, P/Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sonipat on behalf of respondents filed in Court today is taken on record.

Heard.

Petitioner seeks transfer of the investigation in case FIR No. 179 dated 11.4.2018, under Sections 186, 332, 506 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station, Sonipat to some independent agency like Crime Branch/Vigilance Cell.

Learned State counsel submits that challan was presented on 11.6.2018 and charges were framed by the trial Court on 5.1.2019. Now the case is fixed for 25.5.2019 for recording the prosecution evidence.

Since the challan has been presented in this case and investigation is complete, no ground is made out to transfer investigation of the FIR No. 179 dated 11.4.2018, under Sections 186, 332, 506 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station, Sonipat to some other agency.

Dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to apply for further investigation before the trial Court if so desires.
