ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.06 dated 17.08.2016, under Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station State Special Operation Cell, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of no injury and the petitioner is alleged to have fired a shot which did not hit anyone. The petitioner is in custody for over 3 year.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kanwaljit Singh, states that petitioner is also involved in 22 other cases. He further states that none out of 25 prosecution witnesses has been examined. He, however, is not in a position to controvert the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner that it is a case of no injury.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when it is a case of no injury, he is in custody for over 3 year and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
