MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.166 dated 15.09.2018 registered under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

On 12.11.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned State counsel seeks time to file reply and submitted that neither he has received the record nor Investigating Officer has come present. However, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that co-accused Bachittar Singh and Baljeet Kaur have already been granted interim bail by this court in CRM-M-47884-2018 vide order dated 30.10.2018.

To be heard along with CRM-M-47884-2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to surrender

before the Arresting/Investigating Officer within seven days. On doing so, they shall be released on interim bail, subject to their furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, they shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. failing which they shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to them.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the order dated 12.11.2018, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Manpreet Kaur submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.11.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
