Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made seeking direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to take action against private respondents No.4 to 9 by registering FIR against them and to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner, at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, is directed to look into representation dated 02.11.2018 (P-6) filed by the petitioner, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-

Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, to decide representation dated 02.11.2018 (P-6) by passing a speaking order after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
