Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to direct the respondent No.4 to conduct investigation of FIR No.53 dated 20.03.2019 under Sections 363, 366-A and 376 IPC registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) against private respondents No.5 to 8 in a fair and impartial manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has also made a representation (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, but no action has been taken by the police so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Jagmohan Ghumman, Deputy

Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Though the FIR in question was registered on 20.03.2019 and it is but presumed that the same must be under investigation with the police and therefore, no interference is required at this stage, however, without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the contents of representation (Annexures P-3), which is undated, and to act in accordance with law.
