Present petition has been filed with the following substantive

prayer:-

“It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that present petition may kindly be allowed and appropriate directions/ order/ instructions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members and also from malicious prosecution in false cases at the hands of the Respondent No.4 to 11 and further appropriate directions/ order instruction be issued to the respondents No.1 to 3 to take legal action on the complaint dated 16.12.2017 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioners against private respondents including respondent No.4 to 11 and, in the interest of justice.

It is further prayed that the official respondents No.1 to 3 may kindly be directed to make the petitioners enable to enter into their own house at the above mentioned address and direct the respondent No.7 to go back to her parents and to settle the dispute amicably at first, in the interest of justice.

It is further prayed that the the official respondents No.1 to 3 may kindly be directed to respondents No.4 to 6 and to any other police officer on their behest to not to involve the petitioner or his family member in any false case as they earlier tried to do the same and the petitioner could saved only by chance and luck.

It is further prayed that the official respondents may kindly be directed to give the opportunity of hearing to the petitioner/ complainant before passing any order on the representation/ complaint dated

16.12.2017 (Annexure P-1) in the interest of justice.”

Reply to the petition has been filed by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, (South), Ludhiana in which it has been stated that a Kalandra under Section 107 and 151 CPC has been filed against the petitioner and the complaints submitted by the petitioner have been inquired into and found without substance and therefore, filed.

It has further been stated that there is no threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of by relegating the petitioner to alternative remedy.
