The writ petition filed by the petitioner for quashing of order dated 19.08.2015 rejecting the claim of the petitioner for regularization of his services w.e.f. 31.01.1996 and not w.e.f. 20.12.2010, was allowed on 26.09.2018. The order dated 19.08.2015 was set aside and the respondents were directed to regularize the services of the petitioner against the post of Announcer w.e.f. 31.01.1996. The petitioner was held entitled to all consequential benefits.

Pursuant to notice of motion, a short reply dated 09.10.2019 by way of affidavit of Sh. Surender Singh, HCS, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Hisar filed in Court is taken on record. A copy of the reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. With the reply, order dated 16.07.2019 has been annexed whereby the service of the petitioner was regularized w.e.f. 31.01.1996.

Learned State counsel submits on instructions that the payment of arrears amounting to Rs. 11, 46, 375/- were paid after making deduction of a sum of Rs. 4,65,931/-. He further submits that the calculations were also handed over to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the reply filed today in Court, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, seeks, liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law, if aggrieved of the calculations.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
