The arguments raised on behalf of the petitioner having not received a favourable response from the Bench and not to invite a decision on merits lest it may prejudice the case of the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and the respondent are brothers and through the instant litigation the respondent seeks partition of the property jointly owned and possessed by the parties.
