Mr. Vikrant Sharma, learned counsel has filed in Court today a short reply of the Registrar of Panjab University, Chandigarh on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 alongwith Annexures R1 to R4. The same is taken on record and a complete copy has been furnished to counsel opposite.

With the consent of counsel for the parties, the writ petition is taken up for disposal today itself.

Instant writ petition was preferred by the petitioner aggrieved of the action of the Director, Physical Education and Sports, Panjab University, Chandigarh, in having not entered his name in the list of selected Shooters for participation in the 30th World Summer Universiade-2019 to be held at Napoli (Italy) in the event of 25 M. Rapid Fire Pistol (Men).

The case projected on behalf of the petitioner was that for purposes of selection, trials had taken place and which consisted of six rounds and in which the petitioner had actually scored 579 out of 600. It

was contended that private respondent No.3 who has been selected at serial No.2 for the event in question had scored 574 out of 600. A tabulation contained in para 9 of the writ petition was relied upon to submit that there has been a mistake in totalling while reflecting the score of the petitioner to be 571 out of 600 instead of 579.

Mr. Vikrant Sharma, learned counsel for the respondent-University would very fairly state that there was indeed a mistake in the total. He however submits that the inadvertent mistake that had occurred in any case would have no consequence.

In this regard the averments made in the short reply filed in Court today had been adverted to and as per which the event of 25 M. Rapid Fire Pistol Men, had been included by the 30th Summer Universiade Game -2019 Organizing Committee and subsequently another set of regulations were issued by the Organizing Body in the month of Feb.2019 and instructions were issued on 25.04.2019 and as per which the event in question i.e. 25 M. Rapid Fire Pistol Men, stands excluded from the games in question.

In view of such stand taken on behalf of University, nothing would survive for adjudication in the instant writ petition.

Writ petition is disposed of as not pressed.
