Husband of the petitioner was stated to be the owner of House No.104-P, Sector 13,Kurukshetra. He died on 15.06.2014. As per averments made in the petition the deceased is survived by the widow (present petitioner) and three sons.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that in spite of an application having been made to the concerned HUDA authorities for incorporating the name of the petitioner in the column of ownership, no action has been taken till date.

During the course of hearing, counsel would concede that there is no succession certificate issued by the competent forum in favour of the petitioner and on the strength of which the claim to the property/ownership is being raised.

At this stage, counsel seeks withdrawal of the writ petition to apply for a succession certificate and in the eventuality of the same being issued, then carry the prayer raised in the instant petition before the concerned HUDA authorities.
