Report dated 25.11.2019 of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate has been received whereby after recording statements of petitioners Vinay Kumar Dubey, Brij Bihari Dubey, Janaki Dubey and complainant Priyanka, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure

matrimonial and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' **2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' **2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 230 dated 16.06.2017 registered at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh under Sections 323, 406, 498-A and 506 and all the consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
