This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 237 dated 15.10.2018 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at PS Kotwali, District Kapurthala.

On the last date the following order was passed :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is being sought to be implicated only on the ground that the persons from whom the contraband was recovered had informed the police that they had purchased it from the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Amarjit Kaur Khurana, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply a copy of the petition to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 27.05.2019.”

Learned Sr. DAG on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh has accepted that the basis for implicating the petitioner is the statement of the person from whom the contraband was recovered. On being asked about the antecedents of the petitioner, it has been stated that antecedents of the petitioner are clean and no other case is pending against him.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest he will be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 30.5.2019 and as and when his presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
